


Step 1 - Prepare Upper Tube Clamps


This step assumes installation to service body rack with 2" diameter upper leg cups. If mounting top clamp to a smaller diameter tubing, install additional thicker rubber spacers per Step 2 instructions before installing clamp.

- Dry wipe clean inside diameter of two tube clamps.
- Remove plastic backing from a 1/32" thick tape strip.
- Install a tape strip onto inside diameter of a upper tube clamp.
- Repeat for second tube clamp.

Step 2 - Prepare Lower Tube Clamps

- Dry wipe clean inside diameter of remaining tube clamps.
- Remove plastic backing from a 1/32" thick rubber pad strip.
- Install a rubber pad strip onto inside diameter of tube clamp.
- Dry wipe clean inside diameter of rubber pad strip.
- Remove plastic backing from a 1/8" thick rubber pad strip.
- Install strip onto inside diameter of previously installed 1/32" thick rubber pad strip.
- Repeat for last tube clamp.









Step 3 – Window Guard Installation

- Determine installation position and take note of approximate location of holes in top and bottom of window guard.
- Squeeze one tube clamp around the top of each of the front legs, at about the position of the hole noted above, with flat end of flange away from the cab.
- Using a 5/16" x 1-1/4" hex bolt and a 5/16" fender washer, bolt through the top tube clamp, then the window guard, and then secure together with another 5/16" fender washer and a 5/16" nut.
- Repeat for opposite side.



Repeat for lower tube clamps.



GO BACK AND TIGHTEN ALL HARDWARE.
