

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# **Before You Begin**

- Before installing roller bar attachment, crossbar rack and additional crossbar rack add-on must be already installed.
- Read all instructions prior to installing any Kargo Master product.
- Install your roller bars to the roof mounting locations prior to roller bar assembly.
- Be sure to put sealant around all threads entering cargo area and between the rubber spacer and roof
  of vehicle to prevent water from leaking into cargo area.






## DO NOT EXCEED MANUFACTURERS WEIGHT CAPACITY FOR ROOF

### Step 1 – Assemble Roller Bar

- Using one each of 3/8" x 1-1/2" hex head bolt, 3/8" oversized washer, .406" nylon washer, 3/8" ID nylon bushing, and 3/4" ID flanged bushing, fasten the roller bar to the driver-side (DS) side rail, as shown.
  - ! Be sure the flanged bushing is inserted into large hole in side rail in the orientation shown.
  - ! Also be sure the oversized steel washer is outside of the nylon washer, with the nylon washer contacting the side rail.
- DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN. Tighten so that the roller bar is still able spin easily.
- Repeat for opposite passenger-side (PS) side rail.








# **TRANSIT CONNECT (ONLY)**


### Step 2 – Install Spacers

If installing onto a Transit Connect, spacers must be installed below the existing feet.

- Remove the existing M8 bolts, washers and nut securing crossbar rack feet to roof.
- DO NOT remove the existing 3-hole rubber pad.



- Insert additional 3-hole rubber pad between each foot and existing 3-hole rubber pad.
- Using the M8 x 35mm bolts and previously removed hardware, reinstall rack by bolting through both rubber pads.
  - ! BE SURE THE RUBBER WASHERS ON THE INSIDE OF THE VEHICLE ARE IN PLACE WHEN REINSTALLING.






# Step 3A - Install Crossbar Brackets

- Insert passenger side (PS) crossbar bracket into underside of crossbar, with holes aligned with last set of holes. Be sure the tab is towards the rear of vehicle.
- Using one 5/16" x 2-1/2" hex head bolt, two 5/16" washers and one 5/16" lock nut, LOOSELY bolt the crossbar bracket into the underside of the crossbar as shown below. DO NOT tighten.
- Repeat this step three more times until two brackets installed on driver side (DS) and two on the passenger side (PS).







Be sure all crossbar bracket tabs are facing the same direction.


# Step 3B - Attach Roller Bar Assembly

- Slide roller bar cross members under the cross bar rack until the roller bar hangs off the back of the van at the desired distance.
- Align square holes in crossbar bracket with slots in side rails.
- Using four 5/16" X 3/4" carriage bolts and four 5/16" flanged hex nuts, LOOSELY bolt the roller bar cross members to the mounting brackets.
- Tighten hardware only after all hardware has been installed.
